Transition to Secondary School is a significant step for every young person and we as a Trust are committed to ensuring that all students feel supported, prepared, and confident throughout this process.



As part of our approach, we have been meeting and speaking with students before they join Secondary School and again after they have settled in. These conversations allow us to understand their experiences, listen to their thoughts and identify any areas where additional support may be of help.

As we review and refine our transition procedures to make the move to Secondary School as smooth as possible, if any parent or carer would like to share feedback about their own experience of the transition process, we would love to hear from you. They cover all schools with the exception of Ken Stimpson Academy. Accent have been very well received in schools and feedback from both staff and pupils has been extremely positive.




































